Bill # - CFC Position Summary & Status as of 10/13/13

AB 127 (Skinner) - SUPPORT	Reduces the use of toxic flame retardant chemicals in building insulation while maintaining fire safety and encouraging healthy building practices. <i>Chaptered</i>
AB 140 (Dickinson) - SUPPORT	Strengthens the definition of what constitutes "undue influence" over an elder or dependent adult and provides a list of considerations for courts to utilize when determining if an act constituted undue influence. <i>Chaptered</i>
AB 458 (Wieckowski) - SUPPORT	Bars corporations from claiming tax deductions for punitive damages payments. <i>Inactive</i>
AB 462 (Stone) - SUPPORT	Requires residential care facilities for six or fewer dependent or elderly adults to install fire sprinkler systems. <i>Failed in Assembly G.O. Committee</i>
AB 890 (Jones) - OPPOSE	Allows products with substantial imported content to be offered for sale in California bearing a "Made in USA" label. <i>2 year bill</i>
AB 995 (Frazier) - OPPOSE	Would create new barriers impeding consumer organization intervention in Public Utilities Commission rate & rulemaking proceedings. <i>Assembly Utilities & Commerce</i>
AB 1220 (Skinner) - SUPPORT	Would prohibit a consumer credit reporting agency from dissuading a user of the credit report from furnishing the report to a consumer (if requested), if the user has taken adverse action against the consumer. <i>Chaptered</i>
AB 1407 (Bradford) - OPPOSE	Would turn the low-income Lifeline telephone program into a voucher system for costly telephone plans and eliminate most Public Utilities Commission oversight. <i>Held in Senate Appropriations</i>
AB 1409 (Bradford) - OPPOSE	Would make harmful changes to the Lifeline program for low income telephone subscribers. <i>Vetoed</i>
SB 52 (Leno, Hill) - SUPPORT	Strengthens transparency provisions relating to campaign disclosure requirements for contributions and advertisements. <i>Assembly Elections & Redistricting</i>
SB 383 (Jackson) - SPONSOR	Prohibits online merchants from collecting, retaining, or disseminating personal information from consumers using a credit card, except for information required for the limited purpose of completing the transaction or for fraud prevention. <i>2 year bill</i>
SB 448 (Leno) - SUPPORT	Proposes office to investigate possible gasoline price fixing and illegal activity; recommends ways to reduce volatility of gas prices in California. <i>Vetoed</i>
SB 556 (Corbett) - CO-SPONSOR	Requires conspicuous notice that subcontractors wearing uniforms or driving vehicles with government agency insignia are not government employees. <i>Inactive File</i>
SB 661 (Hill) - OPPOSE	Would allow "Made in USA" labels on products that contain imported content. <i>Senate Judiciary</i>
SB 686 (Jackson) - SUPPORT	Prevents car dealers from selling, leasing, renting, or loaning any vehicle that is under a manufacturer's safety recall. <i>Assembly Business, Professions & Consumer Protection</i>
