The Consumer Federation of California (CFC) writes in support of AB 1127, authored by Assemblymember Calderon. This bill would require convenient baby diaper changing stations to be installed in restaurants, department stores and public buildings in California.

Unfortunately, changing tables are not always present or available for families - even more so for fathers. AB 1127 would require at least one safe, sanitary, and convenient baby diaper changing station in men's and women's restrooms and require the baby diaper changing station to be kept clean and in good repair. This bill reflects the will ensure that all parents have a safe, sanitary place to change their child.
